

**Model declaration to accompany the body of cattle subject to  
EMERGENCY SLAUGHTER outside slaughterhouse****Regulation 853/2004 Annex III, Section I, Chapter VI, paragraphs 5 & 6**

**A. Veterinary Surgeon's Declaration**

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EMERGENCY SLAUGHTER outside slaughterhouse****Note:**

The Hygiene Regulations permit the emergency slaughter of animals outside the slaughterhouse if they fulfil the condition:

***An otherwise healthy animal must have suffered an accident that prevented its transport to the slaughterhouse for welfare reasons.***

***A declaration completed and issued by the veterinarian recording the favourable outcome of the ante-mortem inspection, the date and the time of, and reason for, emergency slaughter, and the nature of any treatment administered by the veterinarian to the animal, must accompany the slaughtered animal to the slaughterhouse.***

**A. Owner/Agent's Declaration**

Record all <b>veterinary medicinal products or other treatments</b> administered to the animal, from which the body is derived within the last 6 months, dates of administration and withdrawal periods	
<b>Tuberculosis</b> Is the animal a reactor or inconclusive reactor to the TB test? Is the holding under a TB restriction order?	
<b>Brucellosis</b> Is the animal a Brucellosis reactor? Is the holding under a Brucellosis restriction order?	
Is the holding/area under restrictions for other animal health or other reasons?	
Have any analyses shown that the animal may have been exposed to food-borne zoonoses or substances likely to result in residues in meat? If so attach a copy.
